



St. Aidan's Church of England Primary School Lego Club

Lego club started in November 2008. It is a lunchtime club and takes place in my office. At present attendance is limited to four children at a time to ensure all children have meaningful turns. Within each group there is an equal balance of boys and girls with a real emphasis on teamwork and helping each other to solve problems. The club was offered to 'Star Badge' wearers first (these are children who have been presented with a badge as a result of their consistently good behaviour. My role at the club is to be available to help the group if together they cannot solve a problem or make sense of the instructions.



The main aims of the club were as follows:

- To promote teamwork
- To develop children's skills in control, ICT and technology
- To develop children's skills of understanding diagrams and following instructions
- For children to develop skills and then use these to benefit other children



The next step for the club is now to purchase kits suitable for younger children (Year 3 and 4) and for the Year 6 children who have attended the club to run a further club for younger children using the skills they have developed in their own club. The Year 6 children will act in my role of supervisor, encouraging the children to work co-operatively and being available to help as necessary.
