Course Choices

You will need to choose 4 AS subjects, from the options available for study in the L6. Some students, depending on their academic ability, may be advised to study only 3 subjects.

Each AS subject has entry criteria for the course and you will need to check these from the prospectus.

For students who have not met the entry criteria for an AS course there may be additional Level 2 courses available to enable them to progress academically. Success in these courses can allow access to Level 3 courses but not necessarily at St Wilfrid's.

In due course the subject choices will be in teaching blocks and you will need to choose one course from each block. Some subjects will appear in only one block whereas other subjects may appear in two or three. We do try to design the blocks to accommodate the vast majority of students' choices. You are advised to consider your post 16 options and career aspirations before you make this final decision. All applicants will have an advice and guidance discussion with a senior member of staff before final decisions are made.
